**Claudia Coonen's** arts education started with that first eight pack Crayola box while she was in her father's architect office. Her first sale was out of the teacher's lunchroom in the 4th grade. Arriving in Kona in 1969 she learned attitudes, approaches, philosophies, and the lifestyle of the hardworking people of Hawaii. Later attending California College of Arts and Crafts, and S.F. Academy of Art she received an excellent arts education foundation, studying under Kimono/dye masters, basket weavers, printmakers and mixed media artists. She has a certificate in horticulture increasing her knowledge of raw materials and the world around us. She has taught many classes at Hui No'eau Visual Arts Center along with private workshops in local schools and art centers and has participated in invitational, juried, and solo exhibits since 1981. She received a full scholarship at SF Academy of Art as well as numerous awards and a State Foundation on Culture and the arts Purchase award.
