Into the Light: A Watercolor Workshop

Saturday & Sunday, August 6 & 7 / 10:00 am - 3:00 pm
In an "into-the-light" painting, the subject is backlit with the light source illuminating the subject from behind. Most objects in the painting merge into a few large shapes and become silhouettes. The subject matter has been simplified; the painting is atmospheric, often dramatic, and occasionally mysterious. Students will produce a variety of "into-the-light" representational paintings, including landscapes, street scenes, cityscapes, and interiors.
Tuition: \$155 (\$194 nonmember) + supply list provided upon registration.

Jewelry Making I with Julie Matheis

Wednesdays, 6 weeks: August 10 - September 14 / 6:00 - 9:00 pm
Jewelry Making I teaches fundamental fabrication techniques using wire and sheet metals. Students will cut, drill and pierce metal, learn various soldering techniques, and bezel set a stone. Projects may include pendants, bracelets, earrings, and/or rings. This class is highly recommended before any other jewelry classes are taken. Copper and brass sheet metal and wire are included in the supply fee and sterling silver will be available for purchase.
Tuition: \$195 (\$244 nonmember) / Supply & Lab Fee: \$45

Beginning Wheel Throwing with Bob Flint

Thursdays, 8 weeks: August 11 - September 29 / 9:00 am - 12:00 noon

For those with no prior clay or wheel throwing experience, this class will impart the fundamentals and basic techniques of wheel throwing, including clay preparation, centering, throwing vertical & flat forms, and trimming. Students will make stunning works of art by transforming clay into functional objects of inspiration.
Tuition: \$214 (\$262 nonmember) / Supply Fee: \$15 / Lab Fee: \$30

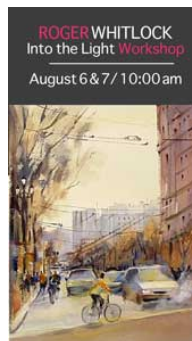
