Under the guidance of Michael Clements, students will choose one of several specially-selected native plants as their subject. The goal of this class will be to complete an 8×10 painting that will be ready to frame. Students will take a break mid-day to enjoy a picnic lunch on the grounds of Pu'u Mahoe. On the southern slope of Ulupalakua, the D.T. Fleming Arboretum is the oldest and largest native plant arboretum in Hawai'i and boasts a truly unforgettable view of Maui!
